

Citing a Source from the Internet (website)

Find the following information about your source and put in the same order as below with the same punctuation. ↓

- Author's last name, Author's first name. "Title of Document." Website Name. Website Sponsor. Date it was posted/updated. Web. Date accessed.

Example:

- Smith, John. "The Fall of Rome." Brainpop. Technological Solutions. 3 February 2011. Web. 2 April 2021.

- Remember the following:
- 1) If you can't find the author's name, SKIP IT!
 - 2) If you can't find sponsor, use the website name
 - 3) Date format: Day Month Year (no commas)
 - 4) Type the word Web. to let your teacher know it's a website and this is where you would put the URL address of the website if required.
 - 5) Remember your punctuation!
 - 6) If it has two authors, do it like this: **Floyd, Andrew & Carla Tew**
