Find the following information about your source and put in the same order as below with the same punctuation.

• Author's last name, Author's first name. "Title of Document." Website Name. Website Sponsor. Date it was posted/updated. Web. Date accessed.

## Example:

• Smith, John. "The Fall of Rome." Brainpop. Technological Solutions. 3 February 2011. Web. 2 April 2021.

Remember the following: 1) If you can't find the author's name, SKIP IT!

2) If you can't find sponsor, use the website name

3) Date format: Day Month Year (no commas)

**4)** Type the word Web. to let your teacher know it's a website and this is where you would put the URL address of the website if required.

**5)**Remember your punctuation!

6) If it has two authors, do it like this: Floyd, Andrew & Carla Tew
