### Homeroom Expectations



- Once students are in their homeroom they will not be allowed to go back for breakfast.
- Students should pick up all materials from the office, counselor, and lockers before entering the classroom.
- Students should not return to the main hallway once in their homeroom.
- Students should remain quiet in their assigned seat.

### Restroom Expectations





- Cell phones should remain off while in the bathroom.
- You will not be allowed to go to the restroom during transition times.
- Students will be responsible for any class work/instruction missed while out of the room.
- Students may go (without redeeming a bathroom pass):
  - 1. Morning
  - 2. Break
  - 3. Lunch
  - 4. PE
  - 5. Afternoon locker time.

## Hallway Expectations



#### Students should:

- Use inside voices. (No talking around office or while passing other classes.
- 2. Walk on the right side.
- 3. Keep hallways clean.
- 4. Remove hoods/hats.
- 5. Keep phones, earbuds & music devices off & out of sight.
- 6. Use appropriate, non-offensive language.
- Have a hall pass if leaving the classroom and not traveling with their entire class.

### Break Expectations



#### Students should:

- 1. Use restroom before walking to break area.
- 2. Use appropriate voice while walking to/from break.
- 3. Buy all snack items while in break line.
- 4. Stay in your designated area.
- 5. Clean your area & throw away all trash.
- 6. Refrain from horseplay and physical confrontations.

### Lunchroom Expectations



#### Students should:

- 1. Walk/talk quietly to & from the lunchroom.
- 2. Quietly, wait your turn & get all eating items while in line.
- 3. Be polite to staff, students & teachers.
- 4. Sit in your assigned seat/table.
- 5. Balance eating & socializing.
- 6. Clean your area & throw away trash at the **END** of lunch.

### Classroom Expectations
