Go to the restroom.

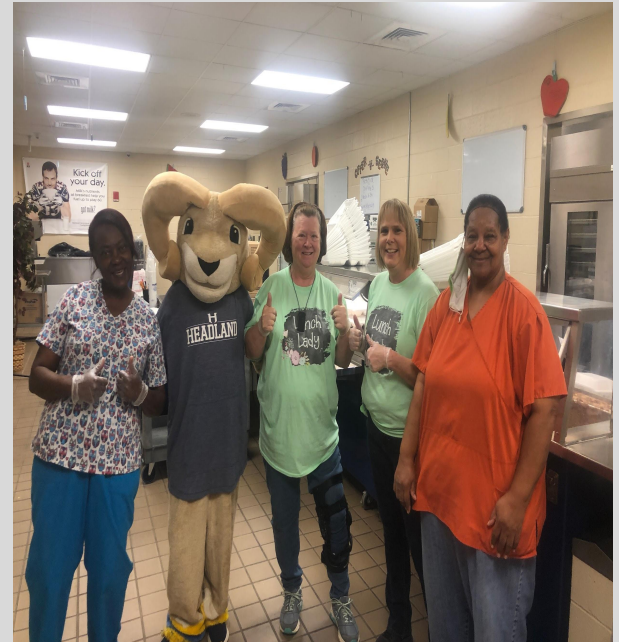
Or

Go to your locker.

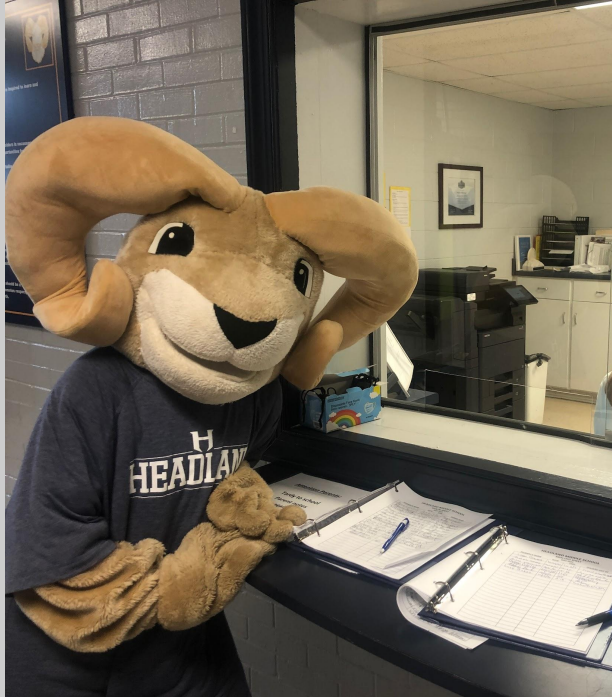
Get your breakfast.

If you arrive to school after 7:45am, you must check-in with Mrs. Holly at the front office.

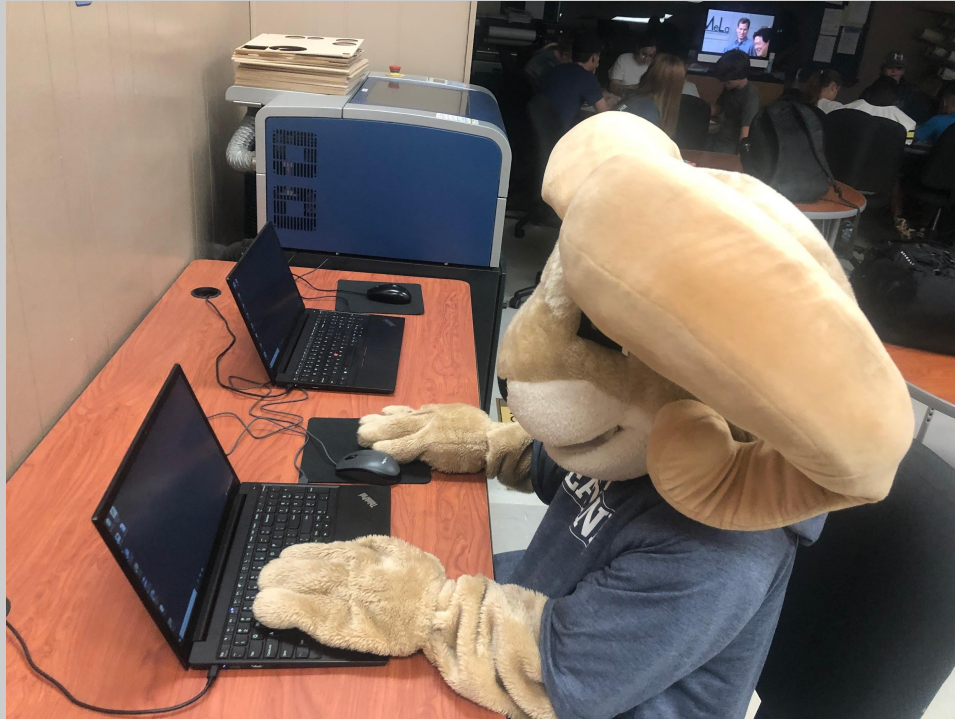
- If you are a car rider, your parent must check you in.

- You have a note or doctor's excuse for an absence. (this should be done before you enter homeroom)

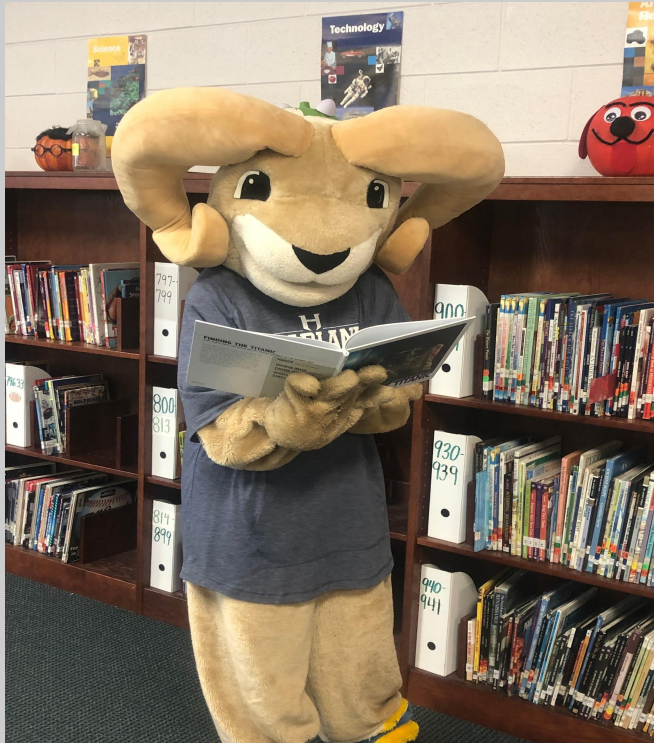
Respectful
