CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

SUPERINTENDENT ELECTION

The Superintendent is elected by the eligible voters of Henry County as provided for in laws of the State of Alabama. The Superintendent is also a statutory officer as provided by the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama. As such, he/she has certain authorities and functions which are provided for by law. His/her duties include serving as secretary and executive office of the Henry County Board of Education.

The Superintendent may delegate certain administrative authority and responsibilities to his/her staff and principals.

The Superintendent shall, with the approval of the Board, organize the system staff and schools, create and fill positions, and assign duties and responsibilities.

All personnel who work in the Henry County School System shall be responsible directly to the Superintendent.
