## **CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION**

SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS 3.70

A school volunteer is any non-paid individual who gives his/her time to a Henry County school or school staff member while performing assigned duties.

The Henry County Board of Education recognizes that volunteers can make many valuable contributions to the schools and can be used as effective learning resources. Therefore, the Board endorses a volunteer program in the district, subject to suitable regulations and safeguards. These regulations and safeguards shall include volunteers operating within the written authorization of the Board and/or members of its administrative staff and under the supervision of Board employees. These regulations shall be developed and promulgated by the Superintendent or staff in cooperation with the faculty of each school.

The school principal or designee must conduct an orientation for all school volunteers.
