CHAPTER 5.00 – STUDENTS

DIRECTORY INFORMATION 5.71

Students' parent(s)/legal guardian(s) shall be notified annually that the Henry County Board of Education may release "directory information" to the general public.

- I. Directory information may include the following data about a student:
 - A. Name;
 - B. Address;
 - C. Telephone number, if listed;
 - D. Participation in officially recognized activities and sports;
 - E. Weight and height, if an athletic team member;
 - F. Name of the most recent school or program attended;
 - G. Dates of attendance at schools in the system and degrees and awards received.
- II. Information described in subsections I.A., D., E., F., and G. herein may be published routinely by the Henry County Board of Education in conjunction with press releases about school activities, honor roll announcements, athletic events, and other school-related activities.
- III. Directory information shall not be published when the student's parent(s)/legal guardian submits written notification to the principal prior to September 1, or within ten (10) school days after the student enrolls. Failure to advise the student's principal shall be deemed a waiver of any right to preclude release of such directory information.
